## **DELIBERATION**

The Electors of the Parish of the Vale have met at the Douzaine Room on this 7 November 2018, for the election of Two Constables, Five Douzeniers, Three Members of the Parochial Cemetery Committee, Three Members of Vale Primary Parochial School Committee, Two Members of the Hautes Capelles Primary Parochial School Committee and Two Members of St Sampsons High Parochial School Committee.

The Meeting was opened by the Dean of the Douzaine.

APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE from Anne Setters

The Dean read the publication regarding the election of all of the above positions.

### **ELECTION OF TWO CONSTABLES**

As the number of nominations received did not exceed the number of vacancies and the requirements of the Law being duly observed, the Returning Officer, Miss Rosemary Henry, declared Mr Richard Alan Leale re-elected to the office of Senior Constables and Mr William Harold Cohu be re-elected to the office of Junior Constable.

### **ELECTION OF FOUR DOUZENIERS**

As the number of nominations received did not exceed the number of vacancies and the requirements of the Law being duly observed, the Returning Officer, Miss Rosemary Henry, declared Mr Wilson John Le Page, Mr Paul Febrache van der Tang, Mrs Paula Anne Robinson and Mr Martyn Paul Torode re-elected to the office of Douzenier and Mr Jonathan Evans Bond elected to the office of Douzenier.

The Dean thanked the re-elected Douzeniers for their work for the Douzaine over the past four years. On behalf of the Douzaine and Vale Parishioners she also expressed thanks to Mrs Pat Devenport for her eleven years of service to the Parish.

### **ELECTION OF PAROCHIAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS.**

#### **Three Members for Vale Primary School Committee.**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mr David Melbourne Bradshaw, Mrs Janet Edith de Jersey and Mrs Gillian Anne Fallaize were re-elected.

### **Two Members for Hautes Capelles Primary School Committee**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mrs Mary May Lowe and Mrs Susan Anita Earles were re-elected.

### **Two Members for St Sampsons High School Committee (also incorporating Le Murier School)**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mr Jeremy Charles Stewart Fulford Smithies and Anne Bernadette Setters were re-elected.

### **THREE MEMBERS FOR THE VALE PAROCHIAL CEMETERY COMMITTEE.**

As the nominations did not exceed the number required Mr Wilson John Le Page and Mrs Shirley Elizabeth Banyard were re-elected and Mrs Denise Cohu was elected.

Miss Maragaret Cleal was thanked for all her years of service on the committee.

### **BY THE ELECTORS AND RATEPAYERS**

- a) Elected Messrs. Lince, Salisbury as Auditors for the Constables Accounts for 2018. This was proposed by Mr Brian de Jersey and seconded by Mr Stuart Le Maitre.
- b) To fix the time at which Parish Meetings shall be held in 2019. It was agreed to start at 7-30p.m.
- c) To take all measures as the Electors and Ratepayers have deemed advisable, viz:
  - Mr Brian de Jersey asked for help from the Douzaine to have the yellow line(s) at the bottom end of Rue du Tertre (where it joins the Braye Road) repainted/reinstated to aide traffic flow and avoid accidents. The Douzaine agreed to contact Traffic & Highways Department.
